

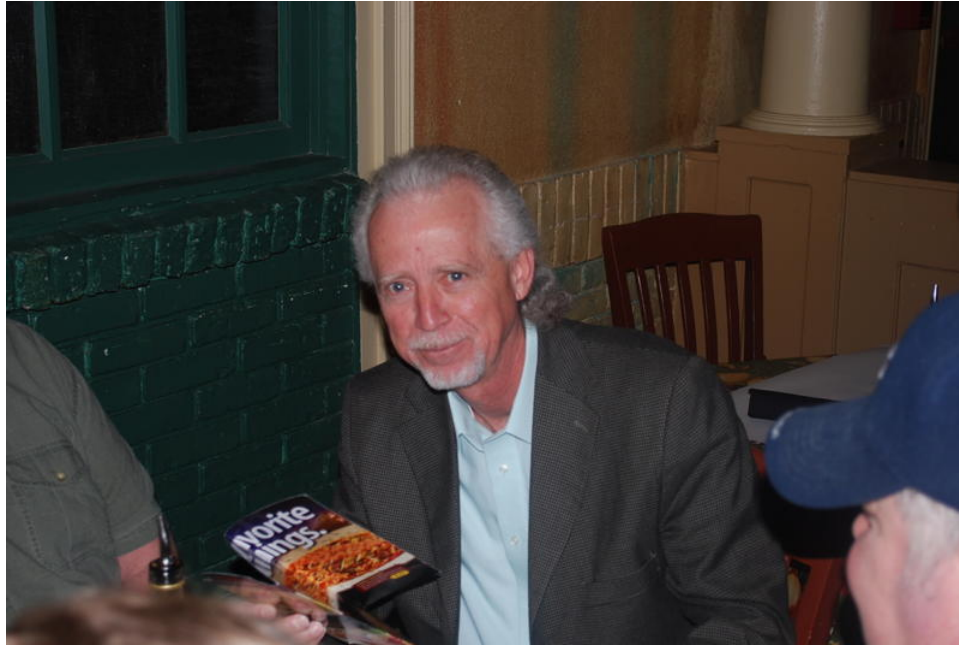
SAM HOUSTON CHAPTER
