

We have made arrangements for lunch on Monday, October 18th at the Proud Bird Restaurant, 11022 Aviation Blvd, Los Angeles, (just east of LAX) phone 310-670-3093. They have a very nice buffet which on Mondays features a Mexican menu (Chicken Enchiladas, Steak Picado, Pork Chile Colorado, Red Snapper Veracruz, Spanish Rice and Mexican Corn + Pasta, Carved Roast Beef, Salad Bar and Assorted Desserts) with the caveat that menus are subject to change.... and they have a regular lunch menu with some salad, burger, sandwich items. Drink not included. Buffet is \$15.00+ 20% Service Charge (Tip?) and menu items are a little less.

**The restaurant is very accessible. From the 405 Fwy follow directions for Century Blvd into LAX and turn left on Aviation and left into the parking lot about ½ block before 111th Street, OR west on 105 Fwy, Aviation off ramp, left at the end of the ramp and right at the next intersection which is Aviation. The Proud Bird is up a couple blocks on the right. Big parking lot, no charge.**

**The restaurant features old planes, memorials and aviation pictures, and a view of planes coming in for a landing at the airport. Mo says there are about a dozen restored WWII planes, including a B-52, an F4U and some fighters, plus a couple replicas of WWI planes. You can browse the outdoor planes before or after lunch.**
