Directions to Pelican Lakes Country Club are: Take I-25 north to exit 162 (Windsor exit). Turn right onto Hwy 32 and go east for 4.4 miles. At Seventh turn right and go 0.9 mile to STOP sign. Turn left onto Eastman Park Drive and go 0.3 mile. Turn right onto Water Valley Parkway and go 0.5 mile. Turn right onto Pelican Lakes Drive and go 0.1 mile.

As usual everyone is invited to Phil and Joan’s for dessert. To get to the Leathery compound go west on Highway 32 until it ends about 4 miles west of I-25. Go left on Highway 287 about 0.4 mile. From left Turn lane enter Manor Ridge Estates. Bear right on Turman Drive to 434 Turman Drive.
