We will have three luncheon choices, as follows:

- 1) Chicken Marsala – Breast of chicken sautéed and topped with mushrooms and Marsala wine sauce.
- 2) Stuffed Flounder – Broiled Filet of Flounder with Crabmeat Stuffing topped with fresh dill sauce.
- 3) Veal Sorrento – Medallions of Veal francaise style with Eggplant, Prosciutto, and Mozzarella in aurora pink sauce.

This also includes: Caesar Salad, Potato, Vegetable, Coffee, Decaf, or Tea, with Chocolate Cake for dessert. The cost will be approximately \$32.00 per person. A cash bar will also be available.
